





Selection criteria for stipendist of "Design your job 3" program

INTRO

CODR "RES POLIS" with its partners (Serbian National Employment Service, Serbian National Employment Service - Serbia; Pole Emploi (French National Employment Service); **European Grants International Academy and** K-DIGITALE from Italy; Electrical Engineering Students' European association LC Tirana — Albania; DOREA educational Institute and Cocoon Creations Services from Cyprus are announcing a open call for scholarship for participation in "Design your job 3" project for young people, citizens of Albania, Cyprus, Italy and Seribia. For each country there are 4 scholarships for graphic design topic and 4 for web design / development topic. This document outlines the roles and responsibilities of potential stipendist as well as the eligibility criteria.

Selection criterias:

Stipendist should be highly motivated and responsable young people. Stipendist need to be ready to actively participate in two 10/11-day trainings, one covering basic level of chosen field of interest (web or graphic design) and other covering medium level of chosen field of interest and fulfill all tasks assigned by their trainers. Education will be on English language so applicants must all least to understand English and speak on a level that they can follow the education.

Based on that the following basic eligibility criteria are:

- To be a young person (aged 18 to 30);
- To be a citizen of Albania, Cyprus, Italy or Serbia;
- at least intermediate level of English language;

<u>Additional / national selection criteria:</u>

- Focus is on young people from 20 27 years;
- Focus is on long term unemployed young;
- To be NEET or a fewer opportunity person;
- People with disabilities are strongly encouraged to apply as well as the young people withouth parental care or who have grown up in foster homes / state social institutions
- Gendre equality;



















ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- To attend all trainings and project events,
- To actively contribute to program development,
- To fulfill the tasks given by trainers / experts in time,
- To constantly practice and update competences obtained through trainings,
- To work of 160 hours of practice in max 4 month period (July-october 2019),
- To assist project team if needed in results dissemination and project visibility.

NOTE: Scholarship agreements will be offered just to those who are among finalists.
